Louisiana Service and Leadership Minor Requirements (LASAL)

Incoming students will be automatically enrolled in the Honors minor. Those who wish to deepen their experience as it pertains to leadership roles in Louisiana in the fields of public service, social justice, and environmental sustainability may opt into the LASAL minor or LASAL Research minor.

Admission to the minor is at the discretion of the college. To apply, students must attend an informational meeting, complete an application, and undertake an interview. Admission is not guaranteed. All students pursuing academic programs of the College must be in good standing to continue in that academic program, register for honors courses, and be eligible for priority registration. Following the initial semester in the College, a student will be in good standing if they maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 and maintain enrollment in one of the academic programs (major or minor) of the College.
